**Law firm Seddons GSC were in the market for a new technology partner to help transition its IT infrastructure to the Microsoft Azure environment when problems with the incumbent managed IT services provider accelerated their plans.**

Seddons GSC’s senior management team was seeking a partner to facilitate the migration to the Azure environment and assist the firm in managing this going forward. The business benefits to the firm, from a very clear growth strategy, focused on mergers and acquisitions, to deliver the desired growth agenda in a controlled and manageable way. With a merger being considered, the scalability offered by a move to Azure was one of the key factors in the decision.

## WHY A VIRTUAL DESKTOP ENVIRONMENT MADE SENSE FOR SEDDONS

Seddons made the strategic decision to transition from Citrix to a Microsoft Azure Virtual Desktop (AVD) environment for several compelling reasons. Chief among them was the ability to scale resources up or down quickly and efficiently, an essential capability in today's dynamic legal landscape, especially given the firm's growth strategy.

Quiss played a pivotal role in this transformation, facilitating the migration to OneDrive and consolidating Seddons' server infrastructure within Azure. By leveraging the tools available through Microsoft 365, the firm was able to realise significant commercial benefits from this streamlined, cloud-based approach.

From the outset, it was clear to Seddons' senior leadership that Quiss was the right technology partner to support the firm's future growth. This became even more evident when the merger with specialist London firm GSC Solicitors was announced.

A key consideration during the merger was ensuring that the new Azure environment could seamlessly accommodate the additional users and data from

GSC. Thanks to the groundwork already laid during the Citrix-to-Azure migration, and with Quiss's continued support, integrating GSC's servers, systems, and applications into the existing AVD environment was a smooth and straightforward process.

While the business aspects of the merger took time to finalise, the technical integration was completed swiftly and without disruption. This was critical, as the Seddons team had just eight weeks to complete the migration once the merger was confirmed.

The decision to appoint Quiss as the firm's technology partner proved invaluable. Their deep sector expertise enabled them to overcome the complexities of merging disparate practice management systems and migrating large volumes of data within the tight timeframe.

Ensuring that incoming lawyers had immediate access to their case files, communications, and data from day one was essential, and this was achieved without compromising the high standard of legal service for which both firms are known.

In any merger or acquisition, technology should act as an enabler, not a barrier. In this case, seamless access to Microsoft 365 from day one allowed teams to focus on their work rather than the mechanics of integration, an essential factor in the success of the merger.

## QUISS’ HANDS-ON SUPPORT INSPIRES CONFIDENCE

To minimise disruption, the merger between Seddons and GSC Solicitors was scheduled to take place over a weekend, allowing any potential issues to be addressed outside of business hours. Quiss deployed a dedicated technical team to London, equipped with newly branded laptops for the incoming GSC team, prepared for an intensive and carefully coordinated transition.

A critical part of the process involved unifying the domain names of both firms and merging all mailboxes into a single environment, while ensuring that the GSC team retained full access to their historical data by Monday morning.

By Sunday evening, the transition was complete. All domain routing and associated rules were functioning seamlessly, and the migration of data, including GSC’s practice management system and legacy file servers, into the Seddons Azure Virtual Desktop environment had been successfully executed.

Quiss remained on-site Monday morning to assist with onboarding, ensuring every team member could log in and begin work without delay. The transition proceeded smoothly, with only a few minor teething issues typical of a project of this scale.

Although the project had been scheduled to run until Wednesday, the efficiency and thorough preparation of the Quiss team meant everything was operational by Monday afternoon, allowing them to wrap up early, confident in a job well done.
